III. Committee Reports

a. Show committee-

May show update: have a judge, form has been updated, Kaileigh will update the online form. Tailored to Ride will also be doing the snack table again this year.

- a. Collect prizes for raffles to be held at shows- prizes were collected
- b. Medal Program update- Kaileigh and Jessica met to discuss how the program will look. Instead of medal program, they're thinking about a patch program. Snohomish has a great system that already works really well, so they will be using that system. Jessica got a show report from ann for the last 2 years. The danishes from previous year will be retroactive and count toward the program. We discussed ways to fit the program classes into the fair schedule. They will create a booklet and a promo video.
- c. Dine in fundraiser check in- Stablemates had their dine in at BV and are waiting to hear how much they earned. Range Riders is having their dine in at the BG Panda Express on 4/17 and it runs all day.

V. New Business/Announcements

- a. Parking and Vet Check schedule- Tricia brought a schedule and the clubs signed up for parking and vet check times. Each club signed up for a time and everything is covered now. Each club will do 2 shifts and cover everything during those shifts. Tricia will email the schedule out.
- b. Fair Schedule- Tricia shared the schedule she uses for her club. Many of us liked it and would like her to share it with us. She said she would send it out, too.
- c. Rein and Shine Fundraising Moms- their club has a few moms who are very excited to raise money for better prizes at fair. We discussed ways we could use the money without losing the true meaning of 4H.

They have had hippology stations. The stick horse races are ran on the mini courses. Cloverbuds can also do horse judging. It was mentioned that Holly took the Cloverbuds around last year for horse judging.
