IV. Old Business

- a. CONTAINER UPDATE: The new container will be delivered 6/19. Kaileigh and Wesley will be present when the container is delivered. It will be placed on railroad ties for leveling. Help is needed at the Last Chance show to move the equipment into the container.

V. New Business

- a. FAIR SCHEDULE UPDATES:

Monday – draft horses show outside, so outside arena will be closed 11:30 a.m. to 1:30ish. Warm-up inside arena will be busy this day.

Tuesday and Wednesday – draft horses show noonish to 2ish

Thursday – we have to be out by 3 p.m. The Budweiser Clydesdales will be with us all week and they will be performing from 4 p.m. – 6 p.m. It may be that small equine is held after the Budweiser performance. Discussion on how to manage junior and small equine with the Budweiser performance. Decided that small equine will be held on Thursday only. ALL showmanship (performance and small equine) will be held in the morning.

The 3 big Budweiser semi trucks will be parked between the barn and the arena. We will not be able to use the area outside of the stalls for the educational day display Tricia set up last year. Tricia will think about whether or not it is safe and practical to set up the educational display. **This information was only received hours before our meeting. Kaileigh will be clarifying specifics.**

GRAND ENTRY: There will be no Grand Entry this year due to scheduling changes.

EDUCATIONAL DAY BUCKLE ANNOUNCEMENTS: Discussion on when to announce winners. Discussed it is likely that this will be done each age-group day while trail is set up.

- b. 2025/2026 4-H HORSE LEADER OFFICE ELECTIONS – Reminder that elections will be held in October and the following positions need to be filled:

Reminder that parents can also run for these positions; they just need to attend the meetings.

Shawna is *considering* coordinating Hippology in 2025/2026 and Stacy will continue to act as the 4-H Horse Leader representative for CCEHC in 2025/2026.

- c. VET CHECK/PARKING (Kaileigh) – Kaileigh will make live a Signup Genius (or similar) July 4 or July 5 for sign-up. Each shift will be for both parking and vet check. Shifts will differ as to how many people are needed. It is asked that the larger clubs sign up for those shifts requiring more people to allow the smaller clubs the ability to cover shifts requiring less people.

Galloping Glory has agreed to help with parking/vet check Sunday evening (haul-in for gaming)

Help is also needed for Friday haul-out day.

- e. EDUCATIONAL DAY BELT BUCKLES: Galloping Glory has agreed to sponsor the 2025 buckles.
- f. GALLOPING GLORY CLUB PROPERTY: Galloping Glory will be disbanding after the 2025 CCF. The club has voted to donate its property to the 4-H Horse Leader's Association. There are black tack boxes, black canvas wall covers, red curtains, shelves, educational posters, tables and other items that will be of use and/or match the county's state decorations. It was agreed that these can be left in the container on Friday, haul-out day of fair.
