### **IV. Old Business**

- a. Showmanship Patterns: Showmanship pattern voting is on hold. Tricia wasn't able to make it to the meeting, so Heidi collected patterns and will email the patterns to Tricia Saturday. Tricia will put them in docs and then we'll do a virtual vote.
- b. Prize ideas- "medals system" but change out the prize since medals are already passed out at fair. Jessica is going to start up the medals point system this year.
- c. Class Costs- cost of each class for prefair classes are going up to 8.00 for pre entry and 12.00 for late entry. Voted and approved.
- d. 4H Social- 4H social for all the horse kids (jan.feb)- put on hold until Tricia is back

## V. New Business/Announcements

- a. Fundraising: our goal is between 1200-2000. Each club will take one “dine in” night. Holly will check with Phoebe about this and how the tax ID works. We will get the word out to clubs through email. Ideas for dine in nights are: Red Robin, Panda Express, Menchees, McDonalds, BV, Chipotle.
- b. Rulebook changes- each club leader (or rep.) has to attend 6 meetings to show at the fair. Groomsquad teams can only go up as an original team- if someone can't make it, then your team doesn't go and that means the alternate team goes. State team points- we put an example in the rulebook, see rulebook for clarification. State team meetings aren't mandatory at the fair- the hope is that each team parent will have a planning meeting prior to state though. Ann passed out new rulebooks to each club.
- c. 4H Leaders Website: the cost of the website is 600.00 for a 2 year subscription. Thank you Shawna who had been paying it for us! We are going to think about it and vote on if we want to keep it. Wix is the domain. Kaliegh is the one updating the website.
- d. Roles to Fill for Fair: Who is doing horse bowl and hippology? We decided to table until the next meeting when Tricia is here. Who is doing parking? Wes, Kaileigh's dad, is stepping down and we need a new person to take over. This includes vet check and parking. You have to know both schedules and coordinate with everybody- including the superintendents. It has to be someone who can be there in the a.m. and p.m. and can let everyone know what they're doing. If nobody shows up for their slot, you end up doing the job everyday of fair. We decided to reach out to our club members to see there is a parent who is willing to take this on. Who is doing trail? The club needs to come up with patterns, run through the course, fix what needs fixed, have people sign up for set up and tear down. We decided to put it out to clubs to find people in the clubs that can fill these positions.

- e. Fair Barn Managers: James and Connie are not the barn managers anymore. There will be new ones, but we don't know who yet.
- f. Hunter Hack- Jessica is in charge of this. There will be trot a pole and cross rails at both prefairs only- not at fair.
