- **An adult representative for each exhibitor must sign up for at least one volunteer position each day**
- Entry form **and payment** due April 25 (envelope must be postmarked on or before April 25). Checks: **Clark County 4-H Horse Leaders**.
- Class fee: \$8 per class on or before April 25 (payment must be with the entry form) and \$12 per class after April 25. **There are no refunds**
- If you are not stalling, there is a \$25 haul-in fee that is refundable if manure/hay by your trailer is cleaned up. Pay with cash or a separate check.
- Stalls - \$28 a day. Extra shavings - \$9 per bag. Tack stall - \$10 per show (must leave both unopened bags of shavings in the stall)
- Member must ride in 2 classes in order to use points towards State Qualifying. Novice Riders may NOT cross enter into any other classes.
- Walk Trot classes for members who are no longer novice but not ready to for canter/lope class. Must show in age group Showmanship, may not cross enter into another class in the same discipline.
- All 4-H Rules apply. Reference Washington State 4-H Equine Program Rule Book & Clark County Rule Book. Danish system Flat Ribbons and Rosettes to 5th place.
- Classes may be combined, and the order of classes may be changed at management's discretion.
- No dogs. Can haul in Friday 5 – 7pm. Saturday & Sunday – gate open at 7am, office open 7am until the end of the show. No hauling in when office is closed.
